WHAT IS ADDICTION?

Addiction is characterized by the following:

- The inability to consistently abstain from substances.
- Impairment in behavioural control.
- Cravings.
- Diminished recognition of significant problems with one's behaviours and interpersonal relationships.
- A dysfunctional emotional response.
